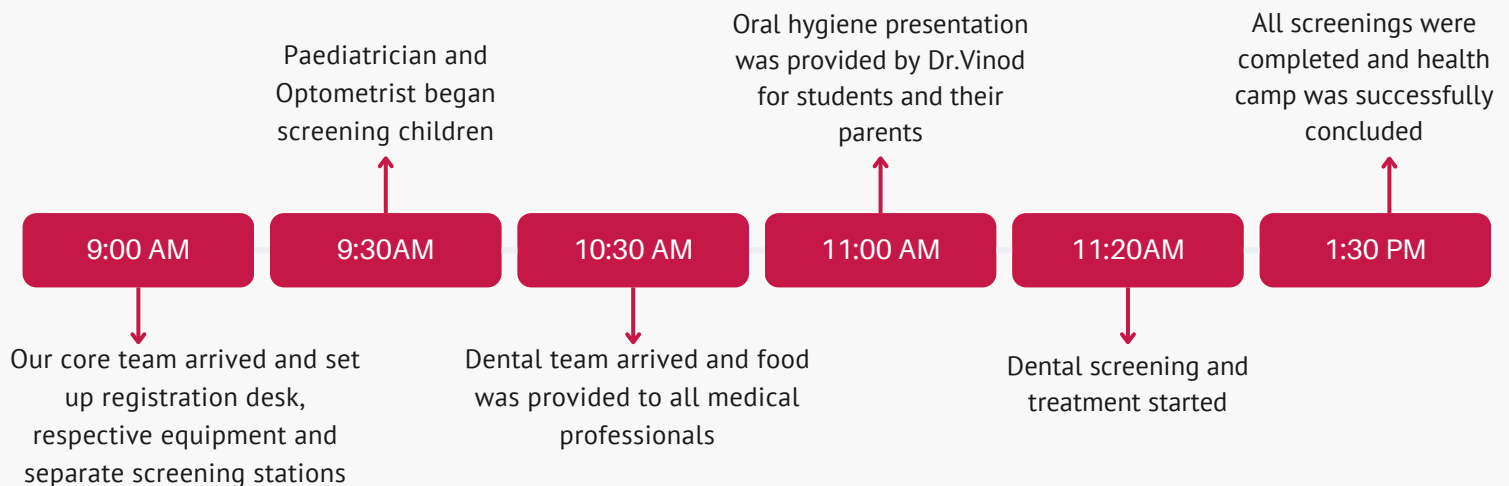


PROJECT CRIMSON

HEALTH CAMP REPORT

On 18th July 2024, **Project Crimson**, an initiative led by **Aira Seedher and Aditi Koorse**, conducted a comprehensive medical camp for students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds at Links Education Centre. Equipped with a team of 13 medical professionals, the camp aimed to identify and treat various underlying health issues faced by the children through a multi-faceted approach. The camp consisted of Paediatric, Eye, and Dental health checkups. Thanks to the overwhelming contributions from our generous donors, we provided essential medical care, deworming tablets, prescription glasses, and dental treatments to the students.



PAEDIATRICS

A paediatric checkup was done for 80 children, ranging from 1 to 16 years old, and administered deworming tablets to all. Paediatrician **Dr. Lillian Tuley Benjamin** identified and addressed various health concerns, prescribed necessary medications, made referrals to specialists, and provided detailed follow-up recommendations to parents for ongoing care.

OPHTHAMOLOGY

Dr. Anikethan and **Dr. Sanjay** conducted thorough eye examinations for each child. Results revealed that approximately 1 out of 10 children required prescription glasses. The distribution of prescription glasses involved a detailed fitting process to ensure each child received lenses tailored to their specific vision requirements. In cases of more complex issues, referrals were made to Minto Hospital for further treatment.

DENTISTRY

The oral health section began with an educational session for the students and their parents, which equipped them with knowledge about maintaining oral hygiene and promoting healthy long term habits. After the session, **Dr. Vinod** and team of 10 dentists performed individual screenings, cleanings, and restorative treatments, in which they identified several severe underlying issues. Over 70% of students were referred to a dental clinic to avail further, more complex treatment (free of cost).

CONCLUSION

The success of Project Crimson would not have been possible without the dedicated efforts of our volunteers:
